



JUST PLAY ELITE 200 ID CAMP RULES

At JUST PLAY ELITE 200 we expect all campers to be on their best behavior. You do not want to jeopardize your admissions with Endicott or any other college due to bad decisions. RULES:

1. You must attend all camp activities unless told otherwise. This includes all meals, training sessions, games, presentations and other activities.
2. Be respectful of other campers' belongings. Treat others' belongings as if they are your own.
3. Under no circumstances are you allowed to leave campus during the camp. Leaving will be grounds for removal.
4. Do not enter any other building or residence hall that is not part of the camp program.
5. You are not allowed to leave Marblehead Hall without permission from a coach outside of regular camp activities.
6. Any alcohol, drug or tobacco use will result in automatic removal from camp, no questions asked.
7. No refunds if you are removed.

If you are unsure of something, chances are you should not do it. If you have any questions ask a coach or counselor.
